The third party conducting the research shall furnish the director of research and evaluation with copies of approved consent forms signed by the parents/guardians of the students, or by the students themselves if they are 18 years of age and older, before the students may be subjected to or otherwise involved in the research. The third party conducting the research shall furnish the director of research and evaluation with copies of approved consent forms signed by the employees before they may be HETE UNDENDED O

8. Authorization of all third-party research involving District students, employees or resources shall be conditioned on the execution of a written contract between the District and the third party with terms and conditions acceptable to the designee. The written contract shall specify the District official who will be the third-
