Principals shall work collaboratively with central administration personnel, other principals, school staff and other interested stakeholders to develop and implement professional development that reflects current school needs and is aligned with school and District goals; and

Principals shall ensure that all instruction and assessment at their schools is in compliance with governing law, District policies and regulations, District administrative guidelines and supervisor directives.

The following responsibilities apply to all District teachers:

Teachers shall ensure that instructional planning is driven by District-adopted goals and standards using curriculum materials and resources appropriate for their assigned subject area(s) and grade level(s);

Teachers shall modify instruction and make other appropriate accommodations to meet the needs of students and to help students achieve adopted District goals and content standards based on stud

To report to the public the relationship between the stated educational goals as contained in the District's accreditation plan, District learning goals and the achievements and accomplishments of the District.

The District shall participate in statewide and federally mandated assessment programs. The District shall participate in other external assessments or testing programs that are not required by statute at the discretion of the superintendent. The superintendent and professional staff shall design, develop and select the appropriate assessment tools. The professional staff shall provide continuous evaluation of the educational program and instructional processes for the superintendent. Acceptable data sources shall include but not be limited to those required by law.
